Single restaurant server	\$27,127 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$49
Teacher and office clerk family	\$55,978 and \$37,556 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$682
Single nurse with overtime	\$79,405 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,039
Single-parent home health aide	\$27,910 median local wage; 1 child	Tax increase of \$59
Electrician family	One earner at \$50,878 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$306
Plumber family	One earner at \$51,166 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$306
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,112 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$495
