Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,672
Single restaurant server	\$27,577 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$23
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,972 and \$39,674 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$682
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,874 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,088
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,036 median local wage; 1 child	\$276
Electrician family	One earner at \$52,444 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$306
Plumber family	One earner at \$52,784 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$306
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,929 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$495
Police officer family	One earner at \$53,723 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$506

Firefighter family	One earner at \$41,134 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$1,108
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$51,919 and \$29,036 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$506
