Single restaurant server	\$26,866 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$63
Teacher and office clerk family	\$56,536 and \$37,688 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$682
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,337 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,060
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,930 median local wage; 1 child	Tax increase of \$391
Electrician family	One earner at \$51,444 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$306
Plumber family	One earner at \$50,489 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$306
Construction worker family	One earner at \$37,418 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$668
