Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,493
Single restaurant server	\$38,558 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$520
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,190 and \$48,693 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$693
Single nurse with overtime	\$101,169 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,419
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,534 median local wage; 1 child	\$225
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,757 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$354
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,086 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$354
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,263 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$354
Police officer family	One earner at \$92,501 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$693

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$61,738 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$554
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$57,789 and \$37,534 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$693
