Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,493
Single restaurant server	\$38,760 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$531
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,890 and \$48,839 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$693
Single nurse with overtime	\$101,055 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,418
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,556 median local wage; 1 child	\$225
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,708 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$354
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,529 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$354
Construction worker family	One earner at \$48,376 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$354
Police officer family	One earner at \$94,302 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$693

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,458 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$554
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,878 and \$37,556 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$693

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
