Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$38,413 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$427
Teacher and office clerk family	\$98,584 and \$57,175 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$193,891 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,925
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,817 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$95,900 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$74,063 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$77,403 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$136,846 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798

Firefighter family	One earner at \$123,739 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$65,732 and \$36,817 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$852
