Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$40,858 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$582
Teacher and office clerk family	\$102,799 and \$57,826 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$727
Single nurse with overtime	\$209,927 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,818
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,697 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$97,532 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$86,280 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$75,340 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$148,948 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798

Firefighter family	One earner at \$155,196 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$66,979 and \$37,697 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$852

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
