Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$40,383 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$558
Teacher and office clerk family	\$102,109 and \$56,217 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$727
Single nurse with overtime	\$206,083 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,850
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,469 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$95,859 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$87,660 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$70,778 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$146,181 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798

Firefighter family	One earner at \$135,291 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,662 and \$37,469 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623
