Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$34,334 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$225
Teacher and office clerk family	\$90,970 and \$46,484 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$130,374 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,535
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,346 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$74,482 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$69,330 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$58,819 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$90,734 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623

HOUSEHOLD EXAMPLE	ASSUMPTIONS	ANNUAL TAX RELIEF
<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$68,429 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$57,088 and \$34,346 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
