Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$34,303 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$223
Teacher and office clerk family	\$91,040 and \$47,032 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$129,895 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,529
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,265 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$70,663 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,896 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,439 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$103,707 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$852

Firefighter family	One earner at \$69,671 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,492 and \$34,265 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623
