Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$34,383 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$227
Teacher and office clerk family	\$92,199 and \$46,085 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$130,155 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,532
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,416 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$76,888 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$71,971 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$59,079 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$83,377 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623

Firefighter family	One earner at \$61,768 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,226 and \$34,416 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623
