Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$35,363 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$295
Teacher and office clerk family	\$101,648 and \$46,996 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$133,999 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,578
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,262 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$76,152 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$63,458 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$59,948 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$110,002 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$852

Firefighter family	One earner at \$77,449 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,470 and \$34,262 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623
