Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$35,739 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$330
Teacher and office clerk family	\$101,618 and \$47,811 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$135,474 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,596
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,930 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,059 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$64,978 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$60,363 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$114,578 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$87,273 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$62,156 and \$34,930 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623
