Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$36,094 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$349
Teacher and office clerk family	\$101,569 and \$48,572 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$137,376 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,618
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,621 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$78,365 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,030 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$61,296 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$119,041 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798

Firefighter family	One earner at \$102,136 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,317 and \$35,621 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
