Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$36,078 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$348
Teacher and office clerk family	\$101,572 and \$48,536 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$137,272 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,617
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,587 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$78,290 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,916 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$61,226 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$118,830 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$101,255 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$61,388 and \$35,587 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623
