Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$35,870 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$337
Teacher and office clerk family	\$94,255 and \$49,329 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$135,839 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,600
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,224 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,277 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,715 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$60,158 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$111,501 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$852

Firefighter family	One earner at \$74,055 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$62,069 and \$35,224 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623
