Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,601
Single restaurant server	\$36,094 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$349
Teacher and office clerk family	\$96,889 and \$49,227 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$798
Single nurse with overtime	\$137,247 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,617
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,732 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$78,153 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Plumber family	One earner at \$67,524 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Construction worker family	One earner at \$60,877 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$423
Police officer family	One earner at \$117,007 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$798

Firefighter family	One earner at \$89,232 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$623
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,295 and \$35,732 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$623
