Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,499
Single restaurant server	\$34,896 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$337
Teacher and office clerk family	\$69,727 and \$60,230 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$781
Single nurse with overtime	\$101,246 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,610
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,873 median local wage; 1 child	\$322
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,772 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$388
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,960 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$388
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,437 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$388
Police officer family	One earner at \$105,766 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$781

Firefighter family	One earner at \$90,847 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$1,172
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,519 and \$38,873 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,172
