Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,518
Single restaurant server	\$37,477 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$415
Teacher and office clerk family	\$81,286 and \$47,869 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$790
Single nurse with overtime	\$104,169 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,503
Single-parent home health aide	\$39,474 median local wage; 1 child	\$306
Electrician family	One earner at \$78,091 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$505
Plumber family	One earner at \$73,744 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$341
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,458 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$341
Police officer family	One earner at \$85,302 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$705

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$74,739 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$541
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$60,013 and \$39,474 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$705
