| Retired federal worker couple | Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income | \$1,518 |
| Single restaurant server | \$37,981 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children | \$440 |
| Teacher and office clerk family | \$84,985 and \$49,156 median local wages; married couple with 2 children | \$790 |
| Single nurse with overtime | \$109,069 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children | \$1,557 |
| Single-parent home health aide | \$40,100 median local wage; 1 child | \$306 |
| Electrician family | One earner at \$80,528 median local wage; married couple with 1 child | \$505 |
| Plumber family | One earner at \$69,136 median local wage; married couple with 1 child | \$341 |
| Construction worker family | One earner at \$56,804 median local wage; married couple with 1 child | \$341 |
| Police officer family | One earner at \$86,414 median local wage; married couple with 2 children | \$705 |
