Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,381
Single restaurant server	\$34,745 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$226
Teacher and office clerk family	\$72,406 and \$42,827 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$805
Single nurse with overtime	\$95,342 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,424
Single-parent home health aide	\$32,697 median local wage; 1 child	\$934
Electrician family	One earner at \$64,827 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$402
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,197 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$424
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,935 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$203
Police officer family	One earner at \$85,685 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$624

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$49,478 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$403
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$60,236 and \$32,697 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$674
