Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,473
Single restaurant server	\$30,452 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$83
Teacher and office clerk family	\$57,550 and \$43,980 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$720
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,294 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,848
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,541 median local wage; 1 child	\$604
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,666 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Plumber family	One earner at \$52,031 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,024 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Police officer family	One earner at \$78,437 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598

Firefighter family	One earner at \$60,081 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$51,475 and \$33,541 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$598

Methodology: Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
