Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,473
Single restaurant server	\$29,898 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$51
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,928 and \$42,374 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$720
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,092 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,846
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,041 median local wage; 1 child	\$604
Electrician family	One earner at \$52,520 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Plumber family	One earner at \$51,133 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,510 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Police officer family	One earner at \$63,480 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598

Firefighter family	One earner at \$52,101 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$495
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$52,253 and \$33,041 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$598
