Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,473
Single restaurant server	\$30,884 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$106
Teacher and office clerk family	\$54,046 and \$42,369 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$720
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,922 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,176
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,712 median local wage; 1 child	\$604
Electrician family	One earner at \$53,144 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Plumber family	One earner at \$52,708 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,006 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Police officer family	One earner at \$61,788 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$47,665 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$495
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$50,636 and \$33,712 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$598

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.

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
