Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,473
Single restaurant server	\$29,910 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$52
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,592 and \$44,051 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$720
Single nurse with overtime	\$85,852 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,855
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,877 median local wage; 1 child	\$604
Electrician family	One earner at \$52,098 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Plumber family	One earner at \$50,514 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Construction worker family	One earner at \$42,803 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Police officer family	One earner at \$78,140 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598

Firefighter family	One earner at \$67,188 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$50,782 and \$34,877 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$597
