HOUSEHOLD EXAMPLE	ASSUMPTIONS	ANNUAL TAX RELIEF
Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,473
Single restaurant server	\$29,766 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$42
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,321 and \$41,287 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$720
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,537 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,172
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,777 median local wage; 1 child	\$604
Electrician family	One earner at \$51,279 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Plumber family	One earner at \$49,040 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,958 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Police officer family	One earner at \$68,624 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598

HOUSEHOLD EXAMPLE	ASSUMPTIONS	ANNUAL TAX RELIEF
<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$50,705 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$495
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$58,017 and \$31,777 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$598

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**Methodology:** Average tax changes are modeled using Tax-Calculator. Illustrative household examples are modeled in PolicyEngine using geography-specific wage inputs where available and do not reflect geography-wide averages.
