Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,473
Single restaurant server	\$30,828 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$103
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,564 and \$45,479 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$720
Single nurse with overtime	\$88,530 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,884
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,367 median local wage; 1 child	\$604
Electrician family	One earner at \$52,671 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Plumber family	One earner at \$50,671 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,656 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$295
Police officer family	One earner at \$76,080 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$71,665 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$598
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$50,082 and \$34,367 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$598
