Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,798
Single restaurant server	\$18,189 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$46
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,925 and \$37,783 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$828
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,299 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,230
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,354 median local wage; 1 child	Tax increase of \$1,280
Electrician family	One earner at \$54,361 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$621
Plumber family	One earner at \$50,090 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$621
Construction worker family	One earner at \$37,589 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$363
Police officer family		\$821
