Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,798
Single restaurant server	\$20,812 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$46
Teacher and office clerk family	\$77,755 and \$43,173 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$828
Single nurse with overtime	\$98,878 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,391
Single-parent home health aide	\$29,544 median local wage; 1 child	\$256
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,149 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$621
Plumber family	One earner at \$60,317 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$621
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,675 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$363
Police officer family	One earner at \$62,697 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$821

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$49,179 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$821
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$60,484 and \$29,544 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$643
