Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$2,056
Single restaurant server	\$34,590 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$275
Teacher and office clerk family	\$63,088 and \$40,635 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,250
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,752 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,505
Single-parent home health aide	\$36,635 median local wage; 1 child	\$246
Electrician family	One earner at \$63,587 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$402
Plumber family	One earner at \$79,562 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$521
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,307 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$607
Police officer family	One earner at \$82,344 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$721

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$65,258 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$602
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$57,757 and \$36,635 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,250
