Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,509
Single restaurant server	\$31,441 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$307
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,983 and \$43,826 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$740
Single nurse with overtime	\$88,640 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,369
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,550 median local wage; 1 child	\$200
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,459 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$387
Plumber family	One earner at \$59,072 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$331
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,718 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$331
Police officer family	One earner at \$68,101 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$627

Firefighter family	One earner at \$55,449 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$531
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$54,831 and \$34,550 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$627
