Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,500
Single restaurant server	\$29,979 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$71
Teacher and office clerk family	\$79,339 and \$46,783 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$729
Single nurse with overtime	\$99,302 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,341
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,409 median local wage; 1 child	\$295
Electrician family	One earner at \$102,458 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$529
Plumber family	One earner at \$101,785 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$529
Construction worker family	One earner at \$70,409 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$503
Police officer family	One earner at \$112,077 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$729

Firefighter family	One earner at \$90,881 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$729
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$64,269 and \$37,409 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$729
