Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,500
Single restaurant server	\$29,845 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$60
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,023 and \$44,243 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$729
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,969 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,183
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,579 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$81,505 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$503
Plumber family	One earner at \$75,224 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$503
Construction worker family	One earner at \$65,369 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$503
Police officer family	One earner at \$74,106 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$703

Firefighter family	One earner at \$61,564 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$573
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,586 and \$30,579 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$729
