Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,500
Single restaurant server	\$29,979 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$71
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,410 and \$40,505 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$729
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,517 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,167
Single-parent home health aide	\$34,671 median local wage; 1 child	\$295
Electrician family	One earner at \$83,945 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$503
Plumber family	One earner at \$75,264 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$503
Construction worker family	One earner at \$57,215 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$373
Police officer family	One earner at \$78,105 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$703

Firefighter family	One earner at \$67,986 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$703
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$56,431 and \$34,671 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$729
