Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,505
Single restaurant server	\$30,281 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$30
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,010 and \$44,667 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$850
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,570 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,188
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,883 median local wage; 1 child	\$263
Electrician family	One earner at \$75,589 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$407
Plumber family	One earner at \$74,597 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$407
Construction worker family	One earner at \$50,805 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$328
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,139 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$607

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$59,479 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$528
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$59,974 and \$30,883 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$607
