Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,536
Single restaurant server	\$25,697 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$19
Teacher and office clerk family	\$64,543 and \$38,845 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$699
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,074 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,211
Single-parent home health aide	\$35,371 median local wage; 1 child	\$294
Electrician family	One earner at \$62,343 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$358
Plumber family	One earner at \$68,208 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$447
Construction worker family	One earner at \$46,907 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$358
Police officer family	One earner at \$64,267 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$647

Firefighter family	One earner at \$45,919 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$558
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$59,115 and \$35,371 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$699
