Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,504
Single restaurant server	\$17,378 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$11
Teacher and office clerk family	\$56,491 and \$31,070 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$651
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,207 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,137
Single-parent home health aide	\$21,794 median local wage; 1 child	\$57
Electrician family	One earner at \$61,348 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$451
Plumber family	One earner at \$66,629 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$451
Construction worker family	One earner at \$41,427 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$327
Police officer family	One earner at \$52,072 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$527

Firefighter family	One earner at \$34,694 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$127
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$50,208 and \$21,794 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$651
