Single restaurant server	\$17,702 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$11
Teacher and office clerk family	\$59,355 and \$31,528 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$651
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,110 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,169
Single-parent home health aide	\$21,587 median local wage; 1 child	\$57
Electrician family	One earner at \$53,506 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$451
Plumber family	One earner at \$62,746 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$451
Construction worker family	One earner at \$40,926 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$327
