Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,504
Single restaurant server	\$16,624 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$11
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,088 and \$30,558 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$651
Single nurse with overtime	\$80,143 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,125
Single-parent home health aide	\$21,983 median local wage; 1 child	\$57
Electrician family	One earner at \$65,434 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$451
Plumber family	One earner at \$73,555 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$451
Construction worker family	One earner at \$43,990 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$327
Police officer family	One earner at \$52,257 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$527

Firefighter family	One earner at \$35,330 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$127
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$54,946 and \$21,983 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$651
