Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,523
Single restaurant server	\$36,176 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$373
Teacher and office clerk family	\$77,947 and \$47,738 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$900
Single nurse with overtime	\$99,686 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,318
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,060 median local wage; 1 child	\$321
Electrician family	One earner at \$67,586 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,136 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Construction worker family	One earner at \$47,686 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$345
Police officer family	One earner at \$79,724 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$681

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$72,662 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$593
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$58,867 and \$38,060 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$681
