Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,523
Single restaurant server	\$39,507 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$544
Teacher and office clerk family	\$78,617 and \$52,674 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$900
Single nurse with overtime	\$104,647 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,372
Single-parent home health aide	\$38,266 median local wage; 1 child	\$321
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,577 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$481
Plumber family	One earner at \$65,786 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Construction worker family	One earner at \$47,839 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$345
Police officer family	One earner at \$85,787 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$681

Firefighter family	One earner at \$69,699 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$593
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,579 and \$38,266 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$681
