Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,526
Single restaurant server	\$37,205 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$455
Teacher and office clerk family	\$68,885 and \$46,080 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$745
Single nurse with overtime	\$92,656 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$2,177
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,568 median local wage; 1 child	\$284
Electrician family	One earner at \$82,784 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$420
Plumber family	One earner at \$83,611 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$420
Construction worker family	One earner at \$52,502 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$349
Police officer family	One earner at \$81,486 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$620

Firefighter family	One earner at \$63,369 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$620
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$57,596 and \$33,568 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$720
