Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,502
Single restaurant server	\$26,061 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$60
Teacher and office clerk family	\$70,781 and \$49,087 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$908
Single nurse with overtime	\$102,820 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,457
Single-parent home health aide	\$37,204 median local wage; 1 child	\$243
Electrician family	One earner at \$96,697 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$818
Plumber family	One earner at \$99,175 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$818
Construction worker family	One earner at \$62,098 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$925
Police officer family	One earner at \$96,419 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$1,018

<b>Firefighter family</b>	One earner at \$44,664 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$524
<b>Truck driver and home health aide family</b>	\$64,493 and \$37,204 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,018
