Single restaurant server	\$29,739 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	Tax increase of \$10
Teacher and office clerk family	\$60,636 and \$44,510 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$666
Single nurse with overtime	\$83,844 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,641
Single-parent home health aide	\$31,117 median local wage; 1 child	\$232
Electrician family	One earner at \$75,429 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Plumber family	One earner at \$73,545 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Construction worker family	One earner at \$51,450 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$322
