Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,486
Single restaurant server	\$26,413 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$60
Teacher and office clerk family	\$50,652 and \$39,467 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$665
Single nurse with overtime	\$69,379 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,483
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,854 median local wage; 1 child	\$232
Electrician family	One earner at \$60,355 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Plumber family	One earner at \$59,783 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,137 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$316
Police officer family	One earner at \$58,227 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$594

Firefighter family	One earner at \$44,391 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$516
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$53,355 and \$30,854 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$665
