Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,486
Single restaurant server	\$29,810 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	Tax increase of \$5
Teacher and office clerk family	\$61,938 and \$44,176 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$666
Single nurse with overtime	\$84,914 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,652
Single-parent home health aide	\$30,594 median local wage; 1 child	\$232
Electrician family	One earner at \$81,348 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Plumber family	One earner at \$74,973 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Construction worker family	One earner at \$65,362 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$393
Police officer family		\$591
