Single restaurant server	\$20,940 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$48
Teacher and office clerk family	\$50,521 and \$33,438 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$687
Single nurse with overtime	\$76,667 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,262
Single-parent home health aide	\$24,337 median local wage; 1 child	\$16
Electrician family	One earner at \$58,990 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$487
Plumber family	One earner at \$59,670 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$487
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,277 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$255
