Single restaurant server	\$21,834 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$48
Teacher and office clerk family	\$51,221 and \$35,611 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$687
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,145 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,312
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,217 median local wage; 1 child	Tax increase of \$1,089
Electrician family	One earner at \$49,969 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$487
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,387 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$487
Construction worker family	One earner at \$39,010 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$255
