Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,508
Single restaurant server	\$21,496 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$48
Teacher and office clerk family	\$50,602 and \$35,425 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$687
Single nurse with overtime	\$81,124 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,312
Single-parent home health aide	\$26,005 median local wage; 1 child	\$2,427
Electrician family	One earner at \$49,014 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$487
Plumber family	One earner at \$58,331 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$487
Construction worker family	One earner at \$38,627 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$255
Police officer family	One earner at \$47,892 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$687

Firefighter family	One earner at \$32,058 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$55
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$60,905 and \$26,005 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$687
