Retired federal worker couple	Social Security based on national average annual benefits (\$24,852 and \$11,808); pension modeled as \$25,000 and \$20,000 in taxable retirement income	\$1,525
Single restaurant server	\$23,049 median local wage; tips assumed at 45% of earnings; no children	\$102
Teacher and office clerk family	\$62,603 and \$44,629 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$715
Single nurse with overtime	\$86,965 median local wage; overtime pay assumed at 5% of earnings; no children	\$1,242
Single-parent home health aide	\$33,024 median local wage; 1 child	\$300
Electrician family	One earner at \$77,231 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$348
Plumber family	One earner at \$81,992 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$348
Construction worker family	One earner at \$49,376 median local wage; married couple with 1 child	\$348
Police officer family	One earner at \$74,189 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$548

Firefighter family	One earner at \$66,777 median local wage; married couple with 2 children	\$548
Truck driver and home health aide family	\$61,330 and \$33,024 median local wages; married couple with 2 children	\$1,027
